To schedule an inspection, please call 509-488-3302, between 8 am – 5 pm, Monday – Friday.

Contacting your Inspector

If you have issues to discuss prior to your inspection, our inspector is available by calling (509) 488-3302 Monday-Friday.

For electrical inspections, contact the Department of L&I State of Washington inspector at (509) 764-6900, option 2.

Turnaround Time for Inspections

Our service goal is next-day inspections. If you have an unusual scheduling issue or other concern, be sure to contact the inspector the morning of your inspection as he may be able to give you a time-window or make other arrangements that are mutually satisfactory.
